Corporate Scorecard, published each year by *The American Lawyer*, charts the success of transactional practices in the nation's leading law firms. Recognizing that "corporate finance" is really a series of sub-specialties, *The American Lawyer* ranks firms based on those specialties. Corporate Scorecard data comes from top financial information suppliers such as Thomson Financial. These charts reflect data from 2004 transactions. (The new Corporate Scorecard will appear in the April 2006 issue of *TAL*.) For the most part, data includes only public, registered, underwritten offerings, including firmly underwritten Rule 144a transactions, but not the filing of shelf registrations.
